

GRAMMAR:

Final /s/ is pronounced as follow:

- ➡ It pronounced /z/ after : b,d,g,l,m,n,r,v,ng,y,
 - Examples: words, sings, gloves
- ➡ It pronounced /iz/ after: c,s,ss,x,ge,z,ch,sh,ie
 - Examples: races, boxes, kisses
- ➡ It pronounced /s/ after: p,k,t,f,ph,th,gh
 - Examples: cups, graphs, books
