

## *What is Esp and Egp ?*

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**English for Specific Purposes (ESP)** and **English for General Purposes (EGP)** are two **distinct** approaches to English language teaching and learning. ### **English for Specific Purposes (ESP) :**

In essence, ESP is more specialized and goal-oriented, while EGP is more general and foundational. The choice between ESP and EGP depends on the learner's specific needs and objectives.
