# **English Grammar: Simple Past Tense**

Lesson : Simple Past Tense

The Simple Past Tense is used to talk about actions or events that happened and were completed in the past.

## 1. Usage:

Completed actions in the past:

I visited Rome last summer.

A series of completed actions:

She got up, took a shower, and left the house.

Duration in the past:

He lived in Japan for two years.

Habits in the past:

We always walked to school.

### 2. Structure:

#### Affirmative :

Subject + past form of the verb

Example: They watched a movie.

## Negative:

Subject + did not (didn't) + base form of the verb

Example: She didn't enjoy the party.

## Interrogative:

Did + subject + base form of the verb

Example : Did you see the news ?
3. Verb Forms :
Regular verbs add -ed :
$Play \to played,  work \to worked$
Irregular verbs change form :
Go $\rightarrow$ went, eat $\rightarrow$ ate, have $\rightarrow$ had
